Polkadot Peggy takes you on a safe and comfortable armchair journey. On this trip, there's no seatbelt requirement, no need for a COVID pass, and the atmosphere is bright and sparkling. Enjoyment is guaranteed, with a distinctive, top-class I wibe.

Words

A tribute to the classics of silent film. The performance is a journey back to a time when the picture flickered, sound faded in and out, and intertitles were used to help tell the story. We arrive at a day when nothing ever seems to be enough, and there's already a bit too much of everything.

Minnierella

Minnie Mouse wants to be a princess, but after the party, when the magic fades, something is revealed about Mickey Mouse that excites Minnie as well.

Heavy Duty

The performance is about roles and status, and the responsibilities and duties they bring. It explores how liberating it can be to break free from these and to express oneself without any restraints.

Money

This satirical act reflects what makes the world go round—and what brings you to your knees when you have no money.

Diamonds

An imitation of two famous, truly blonde icons dressed in pink, enjoying attention, the spotlight, admiration, and especially material things and diamonds. There is also a longer version of this act that has already been performed, so it's suitable for example for birthdays, private events, or show/dinner evenings. It's also a great choice for a "My First Burlesque Night" performance.

White Phantom

A delicate instrumental fan dance. This is my most classic burlesque act. There are several versions of it, adapted for example to a Halloween theme and also to a wintry atmosphere when performed in snow white. There is also a longer version of this act that has already been performed, so it's suitable for birthdays, private events, or show/dinner evenings. It's also a great choice for a "My First Burlesque Night" performance.

Four Seasons

Accompanied by the characteristic phenomena and music of the seasons, the year begins with an autumn storm that brings down the leaves from the trees—and probably something else as well.

Human

This act challenges the idea that things are always either black or white—in the end, it's really the same thing, just seen from a different perspective, and ultimately, we are all just human.

Flamingo

An entertaining, tail-feathered burst from the 1980s. In a flamboyant and nostalgic style, we'll see whether the flamingo's wings will carry it or if the flight ends up being a bit headless but still hands-on. Kick off your socks, pop the collar of your pastel polo shirt, and let the palm trees sway in the Miami heat.

Nutcraker

This character also works as a pick-up character with or without a horror mask! This is a so-called "reverse number," meaning I come on stage with tassels and dress during the performance. Are you a hardworking, persistent executer? You probably recognize the following: Do this, do that, bring this, take that, remember this on the way, and don't forget that. Do you follow your life from the passenger seat, like a marionette whose momentum is controlled by someone other than yourself? When the circuit burns out or when the query responds with a syntax error, more than just charging and vitamins are needed. There's

plenty of torque, but has the spring been wound enough and in the right direction? It's time to turn the momentum to the southeast and let go.
